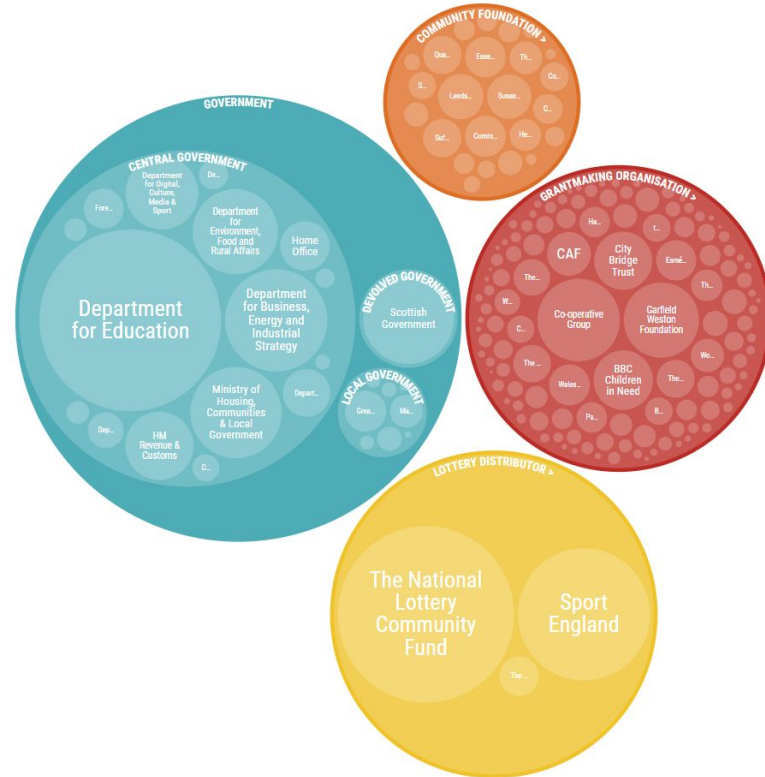

- Transparency and accountability
- Increased visibility of individual and collective impact
- Shared model - easier to aggregate data
- Seeing data with other grantmakers who make grants to orgs
- Improved efficiency and effectiveness of data sharing
- Better data quality for analysis
- Dashboards - individual and shared reporting and visualisations
- Data enrichment

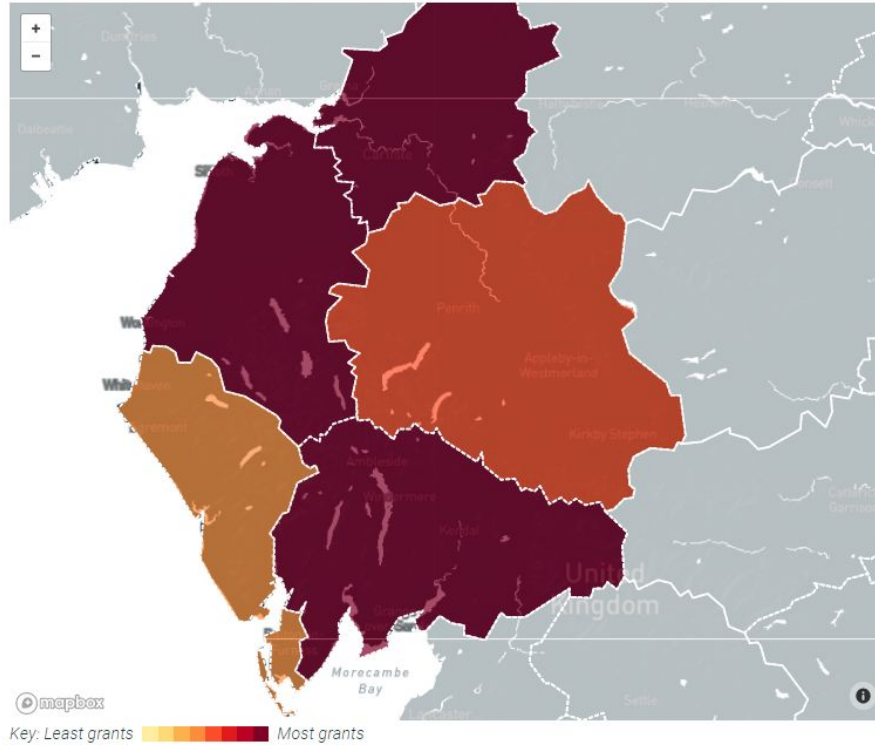

Project Aims

Improve the availability and use of data on grants to individuals to inform strategy and decision-making. This will include:

- Standards and support for publishing data on grants to individuals (anonymously) in the 360Giving Data Standard
- Data displayed in the 360Giving tools to support aggregate analysis and understanding of shared impact
- Support for informed decision-making - including producing analysis and developing skills and culture to use the data more effectively
